



1           3. Respondent affirmatively agrees that this Consent Agreement shall be  
2 irrevocable.

3           4. Respondent understands that this Consent Agreement or any part of the  
4 agreement may be considered in any future disciplinary action by the Board against him.

5           5. The Consent Agreement, any record prepared in this matter, all investigative  
6 materials prepared or received by the Board and all related exhibits and materials, are  
7 public records (as defined in A.R.S. § 41-158.18) upon acceptance by the Board of this  
8 Consent Agreement and may be retained in the Board's files pertaining to this matter.

9           6. Respondent understands this Consent Agreement deals with Board case  
10 number AL16-011 involving allegations that Respondent engaged in conduct that would  
11 subject him to discipline under the Board's statutes and rules. The investigation into  
12 these allegations against Respondent shall be concluded upon the Board's adoption of  
13 this Consent Agreement.

14           7. Respondent understands that this Consent Agreement does not constitute a  
15 dismissal or resolution of any other matters currently pending before the Board, if any,  
16 and does not constitute any waiver, express or implied, of the Board's statutory authority  
17 or jurisdiction regarding any other pending or future investigation, action or proceeding.

18           8. Respondent also understands that acceptance of this Consent Agreement does  
19 not preclude any other agency, subdivision, or officer of this State from instituting any  
20 other civil or criminal proceedings with respect to the conduct that is the subject of this  
21 Consent Agreement.

22           9. Respondent acknowledges and agrees that, upon signing this Consent  
23 Agreement and returning this document to the Board's Executive Director, he may not  
24 revoke his acceptance of the Consent Agreement or make any modifications to the  
25 document regardless of whether the Consent Agreement has been signed on behalf of the  
26 Board. Any modification to this original document is ineffective and void unless  
27 mutually agreed by the parties in writing.

2 4. On April 18, 2016, in a telephone conversation with Board staff, the  
3 Respondent stated that Mitchell Hughes was an independent contractor of Respondent  
4 Alarm Business. Respondent stated that Mitchell Hughes would engage in the sale of  
5 alarm systems and then sell the alarm accounts to the Respondent for a commission.  
6 Respondent stated that this relationship has existed for about 8 months

7 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

8 1. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-101, et seq.

9 2. The conduct alleged in the Findings of Fact constitutes grounds for discipline  
10 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-128(C) (3), in that Respondent Aided and Abetted Mitchell  
11 Hughes, an uncertified person to evade the Board's registration requirements by allowing  
12 Mitchell Hughes, a Non-Registrant to engage in the door to door sales of residential  
13 alarm systems while representing Respondent Alarm Business.

14 **ORDER**

15 Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Board issues  
16 the following Order:

17 1. LETTER OF REPRIMAND. Respondent is hereby issued a Letter of  
18 Reprimand.

19 2. ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY. Within sixty (60) days from the  
20 effective date of this Consent Agreement, Respondent shall pay an administrative penalty  
21 of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) by certified check or money order made payable to  
22 the State of Arizona Board of Technical Registration.

23 3. COST OF INVESTIGATION. Within thirty (30) days from the effective  
24 date of this Consent Agreement, Respondent shall pay the cost of investigation of this  
25 case to the Board in the amount of Three Hundred and Twenty Eight Dollars s (\$328.00)  
26 by certified check or money order made payable to the State of Arizona Board of  
27 Technical Registration, according to the provisions of A.R.S. § 32-128(H).

28 4. OBEY ALL LAWS. Respondent shall obey all federal, state and local

1 laws, as well as, all rules governing the practice of Alarm Business in the State of  
2 Arizona. The Board shall consider any violation of this paragraph to be a separate  
3 violation of the rules and statutes governing the Arizona Board of Technical Registration.

4 5. RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION. Respondent shall timely renew his  
5 Arizona registration as an Alarm Business and Controlling person registration and timely  
6 pay all required registration fees.

7 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. The effective date of this Consent Agreement is the  
8 date the Respondent and Board sign the Consent Agreement. If the dates are different, the  
9 effective date is the later of the two dates.

10 7. COSTS OF COMPLIANCE. Respondent shall pay all costs associated  
11 with complying with this Consent Agreement.

12 8. NONCOMPLIANCE. If Respondent violates this Order in any way or fails  
13 to fulfill the requirements of this Order, the Board, after giving notice and the opportunity  
14 to be heard, may revoke, suspend or take other disciplinary actions against the  
15 registration. The issue at such a hearing will be limited solely to whether this Order has  
16 been violated.

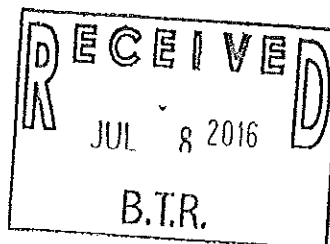
