Director's Corner



The Arizona Department of Administration ("ADOA") published a "Study" on September 1, 2016 which recommends that our Board be consolidated with other non-health

regulatory boards under the umbrella of ADOA, called the "Licensing and Regulatory Division. Find the Study on ADOA's website, <u>www.azdoa.gov</u>. The Study finds that the State will save \$990,000, if the Board is made to move with other agencies into a vacant building across the street from the House of Representatives, at 1740 W. Washington, on the Capitol Mall. The Study also made several other recommendations.

The Board responded to the Study, in writing, on November 2, 2016,

voicing concern over the recommendations made in it. Specifically, the Board is already located on the Capitol Mall, facilitating public access to its case files and meetings. The Board already pays rent to ADOA to assist the State in repurchasing the building it occupies. the space for which is already configured to suit its needs. The Study does not contain, nor has it considered, the costs associated with renovating the vacant building to accommodate staff and investigative needs, and it doesn't consider the cost of moving the Board to the new space or the cost of "down time" required to move.

The Study recommends that ADOA develop one centralized database for all occupational licenses across Arizona. That is a very challenging goal, given that the licensing and enforcement requirements of each agency vary greatly. Just last year, the Board entered into an ADOA approved contract with a computer system vendor, at a cost of nearly \$1,000,000, to create a specialized system that will provide the public with the ability to apply and renew for licenses on line, pay for Board services with credit cards, and provide license verification information to the public. The system will also allow the Board to "go paperless," and facilitate the licensing process. The new Board computer system is slated to "go live" in May 2017. If the State determines to purchase a generic database and require all the agencies to use that system, the Board will have wasted nearly a million dollars and hundreds of man-hours creating our specialized system.

The Study also recommends that all licensing and complaint intake processes among the agencies be consolidated, without considering that the Board is already consolidated (regulating 5 professions and 2 occupations.) The Board already tri-

Committee Summaries

Legislation & Rules Committee

The August 18th, 2016 L&R Committee was attended by a number of stakeholders to discuss the new Legislative Challenges facing the professions and occupations under the Board's jurisdiction. Members in attendance included Tina Litteral of the American Institute of Architects; Kent Groh of the United surveyors of Arizona; Landscape Architect Galen Drake; David Swartz of the Arizona Home Inspectors Coalition; and Michele Guy of the Arizona Professional Land Surveyors.

The L&R Committee discussed the need of expiration dates on professional seals and voted to have the issue brought before the September 27th, 2016 Board Meeting. The Committee also clarified for Staff that out of state registrants can competently supervise bona-fied staff with today's technology. Mr. Foose clarified for Staff that it is a surveyor's responsibility to provide their survey record to the state and failure to do so is a violation.

Home Inspector Rules & Standards Committee

The HIRSC committee was busy at June's and October's committee meetings. A number of rules were discussed for possible and necessary future modifications primarily involving peer reviews; a standard method employed to verify under supervision that a Home Inspector who was in violation of the Rules and Standards had reconciled their faults.

The definitions of peer review, peer reviewer, parallel inspection, and parallel inspector was an important issue the committee hoped to clear up through modifications to the rules. These definitions, or lack thereof, has slowed and confused those participating in the peer review process. The committee was in agreement that peer reviewers ought to be experienced Home Inspectors, a requirement not currently in force.

The committee also discussed the need for committed EAC members. Currently, the committee was having difficulty finding members to volunteer for EAC meetings and to review applications.

Our Future Computer System!

We here at the BTR have been working with our vendor, GL Solutions, for months to create a whole new computer system to better help the public, applicants, and registrants.

The goal of this system is simplicity. Renewals and applications will be filled out and sent in online to expedite the process and help the BTR go paperless.

A new payment system will be implemented. Applicants, registrants, and the public will now be able to make online payments using credit card.

The new computer system will offer better access to the Board's methods and practices with the hope of answering questions without a phone call.

It will also offer staff an intuitive database in which information will be effortlessly queried, viewed, added and modified.

To reach our goal, staff has been dialoguing with GL Solution staff members three days a week via phone conference.

We hope this hands on approach to development will bypass the small annoyances, inconsisten-cies, and issues that usually arise when a new computer sys-tem is put into place.

We cannot wait for the new system to go online next Spring!

October Trip to Palo Verde Plant

In October nine staff members and our new Public Board Member Andy visited the Palo Verde Plant. This was the second trip our agency has taken to the plant but this did not diminish from the experience. The kind folks at APS, including our new Board Member Eugene, planned a tour of the containment building, a rare opportunity that occurs when the reactor is powered down for maintenance.

The tour began at 8am with the group passing through security to the administrative building where breakfast and a friendly presentation regarding the plant and its containment building readied the group for what awaited them. The group walked to the protected area, passed through security, and into the plant. There they were outfitted with white, disentegratable suits that covered their entire bodies; hard hats; protective goggles; rubber gloves and booties; and, a personal radiation monitor. After taking about an hour to dress, the group departed to the containment building.

Access to the containment building required passing through numerous radiation monitors for entry. If activated, access would be denied. The plant station personnel was supplemented by outage workers needed to perform refueling and maintenance activities. Once in the containment building, the group was guided through the tight network of walkways and staircases for the best view of the open reactor vessel and the pool of borated water acting as a radiation barrier. The containment building was large with many of the group commenting that everything in it, from the AC unit to the crane, were massive in size. Upon exiting the containment building, the group removed their protective outfits in a precise, step-by-step manner, a process that took roughly an hour even with help by Radiation Protection staff. The group then proceeded back to the administrative building for lunch and a presentation by Mr. Jack Cadogan, PE, Senior Vice President for Site Operations.

We thank APS staff for their generosity and the unique and amazing opportunity to tour the containment facility!

The public meetings are conducted under rules of order and are recorded as any other public meeting. The results of this formal "evidence gathering" meeting are framed in a formal report presented to investigative staff. Staff then includes this evidence in the Board packet for the Board's review and reference. Observations regarding technical subject matter framed in this committee and are a big part of the Board's evidence of violations.

Do you believe the applicant is qualified for registration? Yes or No

Just a quick note on Candidate applications and Certificates of Experience forms. If you feel an applicant is ready for his fundamentals (SIT, FS, LSI, intern) but requires further development to qualify for registration (LS, Principles & Practice, AZ Specific) you may find that certain question on our current form as being contentious. Answering "no" may not negate your certification of the applicant's valid time and may not exclude the applicant as being qualified for internship. The instructions request an explanation for "no" answers. That explanation is extremely helpful to the reviewer and staff whether it's on a separate sheet or scratched on the margin of the form itself. To that sentiment I close with Thomas Jefferson's words to Thomas Paine in a letter dated June 19, 1792:

"Go on then in doing with your pen what in other times was done with the sword: shew that reformation is more practicable by operating on the mind than on the body of man, and be assured that it has not a more sincere votary nor you a more ardent well-wisher than Yours".

Drug Lab Remediation Program Transferred

As of August 6, 2016, the Arizona Board of Technical Registration no longer has jurisdiction over the clandestine Drug Lab Remediation Program. SB 1256 transferred the remediation of contaminated properties to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ). AD-EQ administers the program within its Waste Programs Division.

During its time as the regulatory Board for Drug Lab Remediation Program, the BTR was furnished with court assessed funding to competently carry out its reme-diation responsibilities. These funds remained with the BTR during the transfer. However, within the subsequent months, BTR successfully transferred the funds to ADEQ. The amount transferred was in excess of \$250,000.

Currently, ADEQ does not have statues or rules in place to regulate the Drug Lab Remediation Program. BTR regulatory statutes and rules are still in effect regardless of the fact that the BTR is no longer the program's regulatory Board. Because of this, the BTR cannot strike its statues and rules regulating the remediation program. This situation will change once ADEQ creates its own set of statutes and rules.

ages complaints it receives, and its front desk personnel already refer applications directly to its licensing unit for processing.

Finally, the Study recommends that our "nonhealth" Board enter into a centralized compliance monitoring program designed to ensure that registrants impaired by alcohol and drugs comply with Board disciplinary orders. This Board has been monitoring registrant compliance with its disciplinary orders since 2013, and, more importantly, its registrants do not have access to prescription medications, as do "health" regulatory boards' licensees. The Board's registrants do not normally appear before the Board with addiction issues requiring medical monitoring to ensure safety to practice.

The Study fails to note any of the positive work being accomplished by the Board. This Board has been engaged in strategic planning for 3 years; revising all its policies and procedures; reorganizing staff and responsibilities for greater efficiency; reaching out to its stakeholders to become more relevant and to enhance public protection.

It is very likely that this limited Study will be used to support legislation this coming session designed to consolidate the Board under the ADOA "umbrella," and take away its autonomy. If the Board is consolidated under ADOA, it will no longer have control over its staff, its budget, or the fees it sets for the services it provides to the public. It will not be able process license applications with the diligence and thoroughness it currently employs, and it will not be able to adjudicate complaints it receives in as timely a manner as it does now. Licensing fees for the Board's registrants will undoubtedly increase to help fund other unrelated programs under the new umbrella at ADOA.

Impending consolidation may also mean "deregulation" of Board regulated professions and occupations. Last session, the professions of landscape architecture and geology were considered for deregulation. The Board anticipates additional efforts to deregulate the science and design professions this coming legislative session. If such efforts are undertaken the State and its citizens will not realize any "benefits" from those legislative actions. But, those actions might have detrimental effects upon the public's health, safety and welfare.

Alarm Scams on the Rise!

There have been numerous cases in which alarm salespeople deceived the public through misrepresentation. The salespeople state they are representatives of the customer's current service provider or an Alarm Business that bought out the customer's current service provider. They however represent their own services and generally aren't registered with the BTR. They usually have the customer's information, making it more plausible for the customer to believe what they say is true. Falsely thinking they were upgrading existing services, customers are shocked to find they now have two alarm service provid-

ers and are contractually obligated to both.

Verifying registration numbers is a good way to avoid these forms of scams. Ask for credentials. All Alarm Agents and Alarm Businesses in Arizona must be registered with the Arizona Board of Technical Registration. ALWAYS request to see the salesperson's BTR Card and look for the agent/business registration number. Call your service provider and verify everything the salesperson has told you. If you suspect a scam, call the Board Office at 602-364-4930 and ask to speak with Enforcement.

Operations

The 4th Quarter renewals were mailed in October and are due 12/31/16. If a registrant did not get the reminder in the mail they can download the form from the BTR website. December renewals have been mailed for Home Inspectors and Alarm Agents.

Enforcement

In recent months there have been numerous cases before the Board regarding solo-practitioner registrants. These registrants operate firms of their registered discipline but fail to register their firms. All solo practitioners in every practice area need to register their firms with the Board or they are in violation of the Board's Practice Act. It is the registrant's responsibility to be familiar with the statutes and rules governing their discipline. Ignorance of the statues and rules is not a defense. If you are a solo-practitioner, register your firm!

It is stated under A.R.S. § 32-141, among other things, that a firm shall not engage in the practice of any board-regulated profession or occupation unless the firm is registered with the board and the professional services are conducted under the full authority and responsible charge of a principal of the firm, who is also a registrant.

Licensing

As of July 2016, the NCARB Intern Development Program (IDP) has been updated and renamed the Architectural Experience Program (AXP) and is designed to guide architects through the early stages of their careers. These architects will no longer be labeled as interns.

Both the NCEES PE and PS exams are transitioning to a computer based test. The decision was made in August 2012, but the change will only be occurring this coming year. A new fee structure will also be implemented in the near future.

NCARB'S ARE 5.0 launched November 1st, 2016. During the transition period, test takers who have not completed all the divisions of 4.0 will be able to transition to 5.0.

NCEES (Engineers/Land Surveyors) – The Board's deadline to register for the April 2017 exams is January 13, 2017

ASBOG (Geologist) – The Board's deadline to register for the March 2017 exams is December 31, 2016
