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Chairman's Communique



The Board is now entering the time of year when several of our member organizations, NCARB, NCEES, CLARB, etc. are holding their regional and annual meetings. I just returned from the NCEES Member Board Presidents'

Assembly in Atlanta, GA. As an Architect, it was interesting to attend the Engineer's event and observe that they are dealing with many of the same issues that NCARB is currently dealing with or has dealt with in the past. (Yes, when I introduced myself to the Engineers as an Architect, the usual response was: "I'm sorry." All in good fun!)

NCEES has implemented the FE and FS exams in a computer based format and is working diligently to do the same with the PE and PS exams in the very near future. As this conversion moves forward and the exams are offered more frequently, they are finding that many of their candidates are taking longer to take the Professional Exams, which is similar to what has happened with NCARB and the conversion to ARE 3.0 many years ago.

Also, similar to NCARB, NCEES has seen about a 20% drop in the number of exams given per year. As examinations have become more readily available throughout the year, the pressure to take the exams has been significantly reduced. For us Architects registered prior to the mid 1990's, we had one shot each year to take and pass the ARE. Missing the June exams meant waiting an entire year. Both NCARB and NCEES are working on strategies to increase interest in the exams.

NCEES' work on the conversion of the PE and PS exams to computer is moving forward slowly but deliberately. It always seemed out of character that the Architects would have implemented computer based testing many years before the Engineers but during this conference I learned that there are many obstacles to computer based engineering exams, including the multitude of reference books required for the examinations. NCEES is exploring many options for how the references will be provided during the examination. As one can imagine, an examinee can't bring in a cart full of reference materials to a computer testing center (for security reasons even though many do bring in reference books in carts and wagons!). Providing the reference on the computer may impact the dynamic of the exam or pose copyright issues. NCEES is confident that they can work through these obstacles and roll out computer based professional exams very soon.

Our supporting organizations are working diligently to improve the access to the professions while maintaining the rigor of the minimum competencies and qualifications. As professionals it is imperative that we do our part to encourage our Interns and EIT's to see registration in their chosen profession. Over the last two plus years of serving on the Board it has been very satisfying to see the Board transition from a strong emphasis on enforcement to a balanced approach of ensuring we have well qualified applicants, and facilitating access to the exams by direct application to the administrative bodies that administer the exams. In the coming year we will be looking at aspects of our laws and rules that are antiquated or don't reflect current trends in the professions we regulate and propose changes to our statutes that will help to streamline the licensure process yet maintain the rigor that is necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare.

Director's Corner



Last year, the Board held a strategic planning meeting during which it committed to refocusing its time and energies on its core mission: the regulation of architects, engineers, surveyors, geologists, landscape architects and home inspectors. To that end, it determined to pursue legislation this session to find “new homes” for the Drug Lab Remediation Program and the Alarm industry.

Four different bills have been dropped this legislative session that affect the Board. Three of these bills have already seen movement. HB2127, sponsored by Representatives Mitchell and Petersen, changes language in statute to allow the Board to delegate authority to the Executive Director to approve applications and issue registrations to

those who qualify with national council records. Mr. Petersen sponsored an amendment to the bill during the Committee of the Whole in the House that would require the Board to refund application fees to those candidates denied registration. This amendment is problematic not only because it could cause revenue challenges for the Board, but also because it makes little sense to refund application fees to those who cannot obtain registration either because they don't satisfy the requirements for registration or because they lack the good moral character to safely practice in Arizona. Efforts to further amend the bill are ongoing.

SB1062, sponsored by Senator Kavanagh, would transfer regulation of the Drug Lab Remediation program from the Board to the Department of Environmental Quality. It passed through the Senate without objection and will proceed to the House in March 2015. HB2504, sponsored by Representative Petersen, would transfer regulatory authority of the

alarm industry away from our Board and give it to cities and towns. The Board took a neutral position on this bill. It passed through the House Commerce Committee and, as of publication, still needed to be heard in House Rules. If the bill passes, the Board will work to facilitate the transfer of regulatory authority over the alarm industry to whatever regulatory entity the Legislature deems best.

Finally, HB 2336, sponsored by Representative Fann, intends to ensure the prompt payment of design professionals and their subcontractors, including individuals and firms that practice architecture, engineering, geology, landscape architecture, and land surveying. The Board has not taken a position on this piece of legislation.

Meet Our New Board Member: Stephen Noel

Stephen Noel, R.G., was appointed to the Board to serve as its geologist member. Stephen attended Franklin & Marshall College where, even though he was initially interested in groundwater and surface water quality, he started studying for a degree in History. When he wasn't doing schoolwork, Stephen found joy in playing lacrosse and wrestling, making F&M's varsity teams for both sports, and spending time with his frat brothers in the Chi Phi fraternity. While at school, Stephen started taking classes in biology, chemistry, geology, and ecology. These classes showed Stephen that geology was the path he wanted to pursue. He ended up graduating from F&M with a Bachelor of Arts, not only in History, but in Environmental studies, as well. From there, Stephen went on to attend Purdue University, where he earned his Master of Science degree in Geology with an emphasis on groundwater resources.

When Stephen graduated from Purdue, hydrology was still a relatively new field, so he looked to the southwest to find work. He was able to find work here in Arizona as a hydrogeologist, when he was hired by John Erickson, P.E., a leader in the hydrology field in our state. It was John, himself a registered professional engineer, who encouraged Stephen to become a registered geologist in Arizona. Stephen saw the importance of registration in the engineering community and believed there would be equal importance in the smaller community of geology, so he registered as a professional geologist.

During his early years as a registrant, Stephen was able to work with a dedicated group of geologists to develop a representative exam that was based off the work done by geologists in Arizona, followed by the

defining of the associated work and knowledge requirements needs to develop a "defensible" exam, which ultimately ended up defining the minimal competency of an applicant to professionally practice geology in Arizona. The development of this exam was so successful that it became the standard for the National Association of State Boards of Geology exam, now being used by 30 states across the country to test for minimum competence to practice Geology safely.



Being a registered Geologist in the state has enabled Stephen to see the importance of individual and firm registration when it comes to ensuring the public's welfare, health, and safety. He understands that knowing the requirements of professional geologists at the time of registration is extremely important. He also understands that it may be even more vital for registrants to continue to review those requirements to remain competent to practice safely. Although Stephen understands that many of us often get caught up in the day to day activities of our professional and private lives, he encourages professional registrants to keep reviewing those requirements as part of their day to day professional activities. Doing so can help registrants from violating rules that may end up in our Board having to take disciplinary actions.

Should Home Inspectors Bill Escrow For Their Fees?

Billing escrow means the home inspector submits his/her invoice to the title company handling the transaction, and receives payment when the home closes and the title company 'disperses funds'.

Some inspectors will not bill escrow, but some do, which is why there is confusion. The inspectors that bill escrow claim it is 'legal' and billing escrow is a business decision, like whether or not to accept credit cards.

Billing escrow is 'legal' as far as Arizona is concerned. However, some

professional organizations may not approve of it. The American Society of Home Inspectors (ASHI) has a Code of Ethics and Standards of Practice. Item 1B in the Code of Ethics states: "Inspectors shall not inspect properties under contingent arrangements whereby any compensation or future referrals are dependent on reported findings or on the sale of a property."

The key here, in my opinion, is the word 'or'. This statement can be read as 'compensation cannot be de-

pendent on the sale of a property'. If an inspectors bills escrow, and the home does not close, the inspector will not get paid by the title company. I admit there are other interpretations of this rule. There was likely nothing in writing that specifically stated the home must close for the inspector to receive payment. And if the home does not close the inspector can then track down the buyer and try to get paid.

Item 1A states "Inspectors shall not

Committee Summaries

Legislation & Rules Committee

On December 11, 2014, the Legislation and Rules Committee convened to discuss and possibly take action on numerous items before them.

The committee addressed two different correspondences sent to the Board, voting to suggest an edit to Substantive Policy Statement #3 that would clarify the split in responsibility between registrants and non-registrants designing installation drawings in regards to fire sprinklers, and to reach out to the fire protection engineering community to ask for feedback regarding whether flow testing constitutes the practice of engineering after receiving a complaint that municipalities were hiring unqualified flow test firms.

The committee then reviewed questions facing the Board, voting against creating a Criminal Conviction Aggravation/Mitigation Substantive Policy statement (instead recommending that applications should include a notice that staff will conduct criminal background checks), voting in favor of shortening the required 96 months of experience for all professions the Board regulates, and voting to suggest an open book exam on Board rules and regulations for all applicants for registration in Arizona.

The committee also discussed whether a professional registrant is required to seal and stamp as-built or record plans if a contractor has made modifications.

The next meeting of the Legislation and Rules Committee will be on March 19, 2015 at 9:30am.

Home Inspector Rules & Standards Committee

The Home Inspector Rules and Standards committee met on November 4, 2014 and February 3, 2015.

The committee discussed numerous items, taking action on some. A motion was approved that would make changes to the Report Checklist Supplement.

The committee voted to suggest that all Home Inspector Peer Review Candidates be in good standing with the Board, have five years of experience, and have completed at least 250 home inspections.

They voted to recommend that a sample home inspector report and a committee brief with the basics of parliamentary procedures be added to the EAC manual.

The committee also voted to suggest to the Board an update Substantive Policy #8 to include the term "Marketing Service Agreement" in the language.

The committee sought to modify the scale of weight applied by the EAC committees to violations of the Practice Act, asking committee member Randy West to create a new 1-5 scale.

Finally, the Committee voted to approve a suggestion to the Board that would substantive policy statements regarding Home Inspectors referrals of Termite Inspectors at the time of inspection and Home Inspectors' referrals of Tradesmen to correct adverse conditions identified during a home inspection

All other items on the agendas were reviewed but added to the next meeting's agenda for further discussion.

The next meeting of the Home Inspector Rules and Standards committee will be on March 12, 2015 at 9:30am.

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inspect properties for compensation in which they have, or expect to have, a financial interest." Again this is open to interpretation, but I feel knowing you are guaranteed payment if the home closes does give an inspector a financial interest in the home.

In 2009 the ASHI Ethics Committee received a Request for Information (RFI) regarding this: "If an inspector...only gets paid at, or after, clos-

ing, is this a violation of the COE?"

The Ethics Committee replied: "This would represent a violation of the ASHI Code of Ethics. 1.B of the Code of Ethics states that "Inspectors shall not inspect properties under contingent arrangements whereby any compensation ... is dependent on ... sale of a property." Since the inspector may not get paid unless the house closes, a conflict of interest arises, to the potential detriment of the client,

as the inspector may be tempted to ensure that the house "passes" the inspection in order to gain payment."

An important consideration is how the client or public may interpret an action. If a client could interpret an action as being a conflict of interest, than a professional should avoid that action if at all possible. Home inspectors are human. If you do honestly/ accidentally miss something in a

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home inspection, and the client knows you were paid at closing, they could infer your fee was 'contingent' upon the home closing.

This may help you see the clients perspective. Last month my son bought a car. The car was 6 years old and had 60,000 miles. He had a local auto repair shop check the car out. They gave him an impressive (I thought) 30 point 'checklist' report on the car. But would I have been as impressed if the auto shop was only going to get paid if my son bought the car? Of course not, I would never agree to that. I wanted an objective opinion of the car. How could I get that if the shop only got paid if my son bought the car?

I mentioned home inspectors look at billing escrow as a 'business decision'. You can accept cash, credit cards, yen, or take a mule in payment, and that would be a business decision. But getting paid contingent upon a home closing is more than a business decision. It is imperative that a home inspector is completely objective when he or she inspects a home. So in my opinion requiring payment in advance of (or at the time of) your inspection is more than

a 'business decision'. This is required to assure the clients of the inspectors objectivity.

I was debating this issue with another inspector last month. This inspector does bill escrow, and sees nothing wrong with it. At one point I asked him what happens if a home doesn't close, and he said he sends an invoice to the buyer/client. I asked if he has had trouble collecting his fee from a client that is no longer buying the home he inspected, and he admitted he has. So I said that if he bills escrow, he would want that home to close to make getting payment easier, and he agreed.

I waited a moment and told him to think about what he just said. He wants the home to close. And yet he has to be completely objective in his inspection and reporting. I know this inspector is always objective, and always does the best job he possibly can. But what would the public think, or a client, if they realized it was in the inspectors best interest for the home to close?

Renewal notices for registrations expiring on March 31st were sent out at the beginning of January. Make sure to turn in your renewal application and pay your renewal payment to avoid being assessed any late fees.

Remember, you can always check our website to view your registration status in order to better ensure that your registration does not fall into delinquency.

Enforcement

Home Inspector Financial Assurance

Pursuant to A.A.C. R4-30-247€ and A.R.S. 32-122.02(B) and (C), all Certified Home Inspectors are required to maintain an acceptable level of financial assurance, as defined below, and are required to provide proof to the Board that the acceptable level of financial assurance is being maintained. This documenting proof of financial responsibility to the Board must clearly identify the individual home inspector as the insured. Policies or bonds that only identify a firm or company as being insured are not acceptable to the Board.

The following are acceptable for financial assurance mechanisms:

- 1) Errors and omissions insurance for negligent acts in the amount of \$200,000 in the aggregate and \$100,000 per occurrence; or
- 2) A bond in the amount of \$25,000 or proof of minimum secured net assets acceptable to the Board that have a value of at least that amount

It is also required that Certified Home Inspectors provide proof of financial assurance to the Board at the time of each annual certification renewal, and at such a time that the policy or bond is renewed, changed, or cancelled.

For further clarification or questions regarding financial assurance requirements for Certified Home Inspectors, please contact Kayla Blanco or Doug Parlin at the Board office.

Licensing

The Board can no longer verify exam results to national councils and other state boards. We can verify that the registrant passed the exam and the date the exam was taken, if we have the dates. However, we cannot verify hours of the exam, the exam agency, or exam scores. Also, the Board does not provide verifications for non-registrants.

REMINDER NCEES is no longer providing the Board with verifications from other state boards, so applicants must contact the state board where they are registered and request them to send all verifications to the Board directly.
